- Lighting at the North Welcome Site is addressed as it currently is very bright / blinding when people are driving into town. Placement of an aluminum shield was suggested by Mike K. A motion was made and seconded for a new light instead of a shield, to be purchased by Mike Killgore with a ceiling cap of \$40.00.

- A Facebook Page titled **Celebrating Our Community**, is up and running. A suggestion was made to attach the FaceBook page link to the website for the City of Weston. Mike Killgore with follow-up with the City of Weston to see if that is a possibility.

Heritage wall:

Using a "paint dot" or marker of some sort on the spaces that were already spoken for was suggested so people know that those spaces are not available for purchase.
